<b>Preview:</b>	<p>Dordrecht's third game in 2010 won't be an easy one. After disappointing displays and result at RBC two weeks ago and at Emmen last week Dordrecht doesn't look like the side they were before the break. At Emmen they actually stole the draw with an injurytime equaliser, and especially up front they were really poor. On midfield things were quite ok and they really tried to play attacking football as well, but they couldn't create a single chance until the late goal, and in defence they were really busy with a dominant playing Emmen. Dordrecht is searching for it's form, and really isn't ready to host the skyhigh title-favorites.</p> <p>De Graafschap's win over Helmond last week was the kind of restart any team would love to have. They won with pretty big numbers (4-0), and although the scoreline was a little bit too high over 90 minutes they were definitely the most dominant side. In defence they gave too many chances away, but unlike Helmond De Graafschap scored from their chances, and in a rather effective way as well. The first two chances they created went in within fifteen minutes, and with all the experience and quality this side hosts the game was already over from that moment on. De Graafschap made a good impression, and I'm pretty sure we'll get another convincing game from them here.</p> <p>On paper this is one of the trickiest away fixtures in this league, and De Graafschap's away record isn't that terrific, but I really can't see them failing here. De Graafschap has many players back from injury, and their level in the Helmond-game should be the standard for this one too. I was hoping for level ball, but -0,25 with odds around 2.00 are worth a shot too. Because of the possible poor weather and De Graafschap's awayform I wouldn't go any bigger than low/medium stakes, but I can't see Dordrecht taking something from this game.</p> <p>De Graafschap has Meerdink out, Chaiat is doubtful. Dordrecht is without Muhamadu, Putter, Van der Sloot, Van Muyen and Longuet.</p>
