<b>Match:</b>	Heracles Almelo – RKC Waalwijk		 
<b>Date:</b>	April 13, 20h00 CET		
<b>Preview:</b>	<p>Heracles looks to be heading for a sixth place in the final ranking. Last weekend they didn't look too inspired at Sparta, resulting in a 1-1 draw. Except for the first ten minutes, in which Heracles controlled the game, we had a rather balanced game. Neither side was really hunting for chances, and except for a missed penalty kick from Heracles right before the break not that much happened in the first half. In the second half Heracles took an early lead, but the deserved equaliser followed soon after. Heracles didn't look like the motivated side it was before this season, and I doubt about their intentions in front of this game with RKC. It should be a relatively easy game, but based on their display at Sparta I doubt whether we'll get a dominant Heracles playing in a high tempo and perfect organisation – their trademark this season.</p> <p>RKC still isn't officially relegated. They stopped their losing streak last week with a surprise win over Vitesse, and as Willem II didn't win at Groningen RKC's hope is still alive – in theory. Against Vitesse they played a convincing game. Their 4-1 win was 100% deserved and they were finally rewarded for a good display, as several times before this season they did play acceptable football but didn't get any points. This time things were totally different, although Vitesse had a role in it too: RKC dominated the game, created lots of chances, but we should also mention Vitesse's horrible display. RKC plays with a nothing-to-lose attitude, and Vitesse was clearly troubled by that. Here at Heracles I expect the same kind of attitude from RKC, though they'll this time face a much better organised opponent.</p> <p>I would go for goals here. RKC will try to make it an attractive game and will fight for a result to avoid relegation for one more week, and I doubt whether Heracles can get a result here. The -1,75 handicap is really too big for this game and there's some value on RKC +1,75, but I would prefer to go for goals here. Heracles hasn't the kind of team to make this a defensive encounter, and I expect quite some goals here.</p> <p>Heracles has no serious absentees, RKC misses Berger.</p>
